Entry requirements

Entries for the competition will open on the 1st January and close on midnight 12th March 2026.

To enter the competition, people must submit their images by e-mail to: ccc2026comp@yahoo.com
Attaching up three images in jpeg format (not exceeding 18MB). The title of each image must be included in the file name.

The content of the e-mail must also include the photographer's name, e-mail and contact number.
*Young people under the age of 18 must provide contact information for a parent or guardian.

All images entered will be displayed at the Clubs Annual Exhibition at Cranleigh village hall on 28th March when the winners will be announced.

Competition Rules

Images entered must be entirely the work of the photographer. Composite or Montage images are permitted in the Colour, Monochrome and Open categories, provided all component elements meet this requirement. Entrants must own the copyright of all parts of all images used in any submitted entry. The Cranleigh Camera Club assumes no liability for misuse of copyright. For the avoidance of doubt, the following are not allowed: use of images from any other source including, but not limited to, generative AI, picture elements available within editing software (eg. replacement skies), royalty-free images, and clipart.

Judging will take place by a panel of club members, with winners being awarded 1st, 2nd and 3rd places followed by 'highly commended'.
